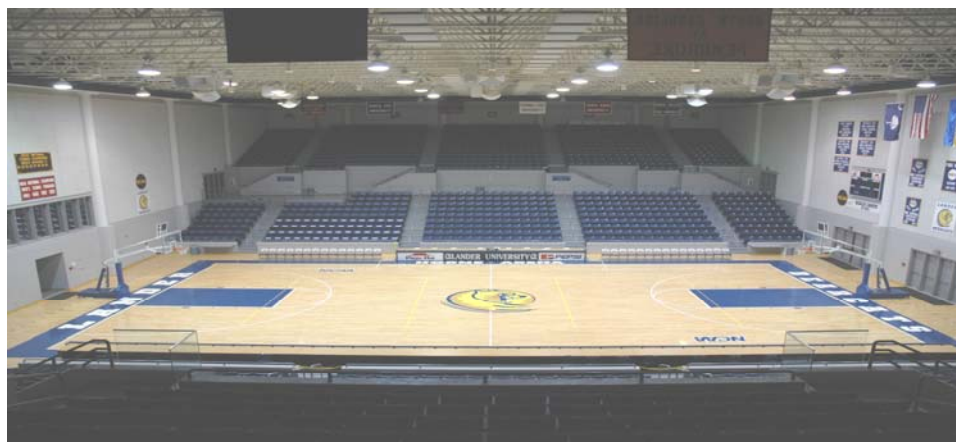
JEFF BURKHAMER – HEAD COACH/CAMP DIRECTOR

Dear High School Coaches,

“I would like to invite you to our 2011 Lander Team Camp. Our two day team camp will allow players and coaches an opportunity to get a “sneak preview” into next season. Each team will play a total of 6 games in our outstanding facilities. Intense competition and a quality learning environment is our goal for each team. I believe your team will enjoy our beautiful campus and will see that Greenwood is a terrific college town. We want to have the best team camp in the south.”

Facilities: Finis Horne Arena (Home of the Bearcats) and the Physical Education and Exercise Studies building (PEES) will be used for team camp. This allows 4 full sized courts to be utilized at one time. We will provide clock operators and officials for each court.



HORNE ARENA

Cost: \$450.00 per team. Cost for additional teams is \$400.00 per team (ex. another varsity squad or JV team). **Lodging is an extra \$25.00 per person and meals are an additional \$25.00 per person for three meals in the dining hall.** A \$50.00 non refundable deposit is required to reserve a spot in camp. Deposit deadline is June 10th. A \$100.00 key deposit will be required for each team that is staying in the dorms. The deposit will be refunded once all keys are returned. If more than two keys are lost an additional \$50.00 will be required for each lost key.

Meals: All on campus meals will be prepared by Aramark Dining Services and eaten in the newly renovated LU dining hall that is located in the Cultural Center. Meals are “all you can eat and drink” and also feature desserts and ice cream. Teams may choose to eat on their own at local restaurants or in our cafeteria. Friday dinner and Saturday breakfast and lunch will be served to those teams wishing to eat on campus. **Cost for the three meals on campus is an extra \$25.00 per person.**

Concessions: We will have a concession stand/camp store available for snacks, drinks, etc. in the arena.

On Campus Housing: All boarding campers/coaches will be housed in air conditioned dormitories on the LU campus. Cost for overnight campers is \$25.00 per person. Lost keys will cost \$50.00.

Articles to bring: Towels, bed linens and pillows (single bed), personal hygiene items (toilet articles), basketball shoes, socks, shorts, t-shirts, etc. DO NOT bring unnecessary valuables to camp. The camp will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Registration: Camp registration will take place in Horne Arena between 12:00 N and 1:30 PM on Friday, June 17th. There are a limited number of spaces available and teams will be admitted on a first come basis. There will be a mandatory meeting for all coaches and players at 1:45 PM in Horne Arena. Games will begin at 2:30 PM.

Games: Each team will play a total of 6 games. We will try to schedule games with similar opponents to give you the best competitive situation for your team.

Camp Features:

- ** Free admission for family, friends, and fans!
- ** Officials for every game - coaches will not have to officiate or keep score
- ** Priority scheduling – matchup teams of alike abilities to create the most competitive teaching/learning environment
- ** Trainer on duty at all times
- ** Each camper will receive a camp t-shirt

Conduct: Any serious violation of regulations, such as willful damage to the University's property or other behavior deemed detrimental to the campers, will result in immediate dismissal. There will be no refund of fees upon expulsion or voluntary withdrawal from the camp.

Eligibility: All players must have high school eligibility remaining for the 2011-2012 basketball season.

Camp Game Rules:

- ** Special camp rules to speed up the game and allow for more playing time
- ** Three minute halftime
- ** Players must wear same colored jerseys/shirts

Team Roster: Teams must consist of a minimum of 7 players and a maximum of 15 players. Each team must have an adult coach on the sidelines with them during games.

Physicals: Head Coaches are responsible for having a copy of each player's physical with them in case of emergency.

Transportation: Teams are required to provide their own transportation to and from campus and throughout the weekend.

Basketballs: Teams need to bring their own basketballs for practice and warm up drills prior to games. Game balls will be provided.

Coaches Hospitality Room: A coach's hospitality room will be available for all coaches on Friday evening. Food and drinks will be provided and the LU Coaching Staff will be available for X' and O's conversations.

LANDER HEAD BASKETBALL COACH JEFF BURKHAMER

Jeff Burkhamer became only the fourth men's basketball coach in Lander basketball history when he was hired in March of 2009. He has been a successful head coach at the NCAA Division II and Junior College levels and as an assistant coach in the CBA and at the NCAA Division I level. As a head coach Burkhamer's teams have won 70% of their games and won 20 or more games in nine of those fifteen seasons. He has coached in 8 regional tournaments and 6 national tournaments. Most recently, Burkhamer led PBC rival Armstrong Atlantic State to four NCAA tournaments in his last six seasons at AASU and had the highest winning percentage in school history. Burkhamer has been chosen the Conference Coach of the Year four times, the Region Coach of the Year twice, was named the College Coach of the Year for the state of Georgia, and was named National Junior College Coach of the Year by College Sport Magazine. Burkhamer's overall head coaching record is 310-148 and his teams have averaged 21 wins per season. Burkhamer has tremendous experience with summer basketball camps as a player and as a coach. Burkhamer has run his own successful summer basketball camps for the past 28 years.
