**HONORS INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM (HIP)
 APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION**

Program Entry Requirements:

Admission of entering freshmen to the Honors International Program is contingent on the applicant meeting, in the judgment of the Director of the HIP, any two of the following four criteria:

1. Successful completion of a rigorous high school level course of study including AP and/or Honors courses, if available;
2. Placement in the top ten percent of the graduating high school class;
3. A SAT composite score of 1100 or higher; and
4. Outstanding talent in the arts as evidenced by a portfolio of creative work, or a tape of a performance, or an audition.

Admission of currently-enrolled Lander students who hold a GPA of 3.0 or higher may apply to enter the Honors International Program. A recommendation from a full-time Lander professor is required. Students who are transferring to Lander from another accredited institution may apply to enter the program if they have earned a 3.0 GPA.
