- ✓ Accuracy... Are sources cited?
- ✓ Authorship... who has created the site?
- ✓ Bias.. Is this an ad? Propaganda?
- ✓ Scope.. How much detail is included?
- ✓ Currency.. When was the site last updated?
- ✓ Style... Is it professional and appropriate to the info?
- ✓ Links... Can you find similar sites from this page?
