HISTORY — SECONDARY TEACHER CERTIFICATION

Students seeking Secondary Teacher Certification should meet the social studies education standards of the National Council for Social Studies and the Lander University College of Education's conceptual framework.

Students pursuing a Bachelor of Arts degree must complete SIX semester hours of intermediate foreign language or demonstrate proficiency at the intermediate level. Teaching certification students also complete a pedagogy concentration.
