MUSIC — K-12 TEACHER CERTIFICATION

Students pursuing K-12 teacher certification are prepared for the organization and administration of school music programs in grades K-12. These students are assigned co-advisors from the Department of Music and from the College of Education. Students are encouraged to become familiar with "Guidelines for All Teacher Education Programs."

Upon completion of the degree, the student will be certified in instrumental or choral music by the South Carolina State Department of Education. Students wishing certification in both areas will pursue a suitable course of study approved by the music faculty.

Students majoring in music are expected to gain knowledge and skills in the areas of performance, aural skills and analysis, heightening the student's musical awareness and sensitivity to the broadest spectrum of music. This prepares the student for possible graduate study and the pursuit of a career in music. Lander University is fully accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music and offers a comprehensive program of music study designed to promote musical literacy and artistry.
