

# SOCIOLOGY – CRIMINAL JUSTICE MANAGEMENT EMPHASIS

Lander University's Criminal Justice Management Program is an online B.S. degree completion program specifically designed for individuals who have at least TWO-YEARS EXPERIENCE working in law enforcement (or who are currently working in law enforcement) and who already have an Associate's degree in Criminal Justice or a related field. The program affords law enforcement and criminal justice professionals the opportunity to earn a degree while working full-time in their field. All of the core CJM classes are offered online, with flexible assignments and assessments.

**Criminal justice** is the system of law enforcement, the bar, the judiciary, corrections, and probation that is directly involved in the Apprehension, Prosecution, Defense, Sentencing, Incarceration, and Supervision of those suspected of or charged with criminal offenses. It is a term used for the series of steps involved in proving any criminal activity like gathering evidences, arresting the accused, conducting trials, making defense, pronouncing judgment after the crime is proved, carrying out punishment.
