

ELEMENTARY EDUCATION

Teachers play an important role in fostering the intellectual and social development of children during their formative years. The education that teachers impart plays a key role in determining the future prospects of their students. From preschools to high schools, both private & public schools, teachers provide the tools and the environment for their students to develop into responsible adults. Public school teachers must be licensed, which typically requires a bachelor's degree and completion of an approved teacher education program.

Students majoring in elementary education will study and practice methods appropriate for the elementary classroom and take courses related to all of the academic areas normally taught in elementary school.
